#### Features:

Dine is a fresh and elegant take on the classic stacking monoshell chair type epitomised by Arne Jacobsen, but this time coming from the studio of PearsonLloyd, for Allermuir. Great effort has been made to successfully create an excellent ergonomic, laminated plywood, form with soft flowing, beautifully proportioned profile, providing a comfortable sit for dining, meeting and general multi-purpose use. The beech shell is offered clear lacquered and in a number of stain or colour finishes in side chair and armchair options, both with simple four legged tubular framework. The armchair has a stylish, unique and efficient moulded plastic armrest made from what is called a 'technical plastic' due to its extra strength. This is a competitively priced design offering great versatility, comfort and value for a multitude of every day uses.

#### Finishes:

The frames can be Epoxy Polyester Powder Coated (EPPC), bright or satin chrome plated from our range of metal finishes. The beech shells can be clear lacquered, stained and lacquered, or solid coloured from our range of stains and wood colours. Arms are black as standard.

#### Marketplace:

This is a truly flexible, but uncomplicated design that lends itself to restaurants, cafes, bistros and the multitude of coffee bars around today, but also equally to corporate dining or meeting use in the same way that the Jacobsen 3107 classic monoshell chair is specified. The profile is subtle while being contemporary with classic aspirations, but it is pleasing to the eye and well balanced with carefully thought out proportions that relate directly to the surface form.
