

The Center for New Media at Kalamazoo Valley Community College is a state-of-the-art facility in the expanded, renovated and technically upgraded W.S. Dewey Building in downtown Kalamazoo. The street-level Arcus Gallery showcases student projects, promoting a creative and open learning environment.

“The facility design allows KVCC to show off the programs within this space,” says Jason Novotny, Project Architect, Eckert Wordell.
