

# INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS CULTURED MARBLE VANITY TOPS

**ATTENTION!** Please inspect this product thoroughly prior to installation. Installation of this product constitutes acceptance.

**Before Beginning:** This vanity top accommodates a 4" center set lavatory faucet with remote control drain. To complete installation, you will also need hot and cold water supply lines, shut-

off valves, drain connection, including a 1-1/4" lavatory trap and a good pipe compound for use on male pipe threads for all water connections. You may also want to use sealant to secure the top of the vanity cabinet.


**A word of Caution:** The new Vanity Top is made of Cultured Marble. It is ruggedly constructed: however extra

care should be exercised during installation when rough handling and the dangers of dropped tools threaten to chip or crack it.

**Water Supply:** If your water line is through the wall, install an Angle Stop. If it is through the floor, install a Straight Stop.


## Installing Vanity Tops


Remove the vanity top from the carton and place on the vanity for a trial fit. Insure the vanity top is the proper size. Check to make sure there is ample room for the fittings, water supply and drain connections.

Mount the faucet and drain assembly in accordance with the instructions supplied with the faucet. The gaskets supplied with the faucet and drain should provide an adequate water seal. If additional protection is desired, use only a 100% silicone sealant. **The use of plumbers putty may adversely effect the structural integrity of the vanity top and will void the warranty.**

**Recommended, but optional -** The weight of the vanity top with properly installed waterlines and drain trap should hold the vanity top firmly in place. However, you may want to place a bead of sealant (not supplied) around the edge of the vanity surface just before placing the vanity top in position permanently. Let the sealant set for 24 hours for firm, secure installation.

Now connect the water supply lines and drain lines to finish the installation.

## Care and Cleaning of Cultured Marble Vanity Tops


You new vanity top is made of stain, acid and abrasion resistant cultured marble, but like all fine finishes, requires reasonable care. For day-to-day cleaning, wash with warm water, a soft cloth and a mild detergent such as Crane Tub and Shower Cleaner, Mr. Clean or Lestoil. On extremely stubborn stains use one of the powdered detergents, such as Spic & Span on a damp sponge or scouring pad of nylon, saran or polyethylene. Never use abrasive scouring powders, cleaners or pads as they tend to create microgrooves that dull the finish and allow dirt to work into the surface. To maintain the high luster (Silkstone Excluded) of the unit we recommend that the surface be waxed periodically with a good non-abrasive automotive wax.

# Installation of Crane Plumbing Sidesplash


Sold separately (not available for oval bowl models)  
Check with your retailer for stock or special order availability

- 1** For best results, the edge of your vanity top should touch the wall where the sidesplash will be installed.

**Check for proper fit of side splash to vanity top.**



- 2** Apply Clear Adhesive Silicone Sealant generously to the rough inside of the side-splash



- 3** Firmly press the side splash to the wall. Let side splash set for 24 hours before applying a small bead of sealant on all four edges.

**Remember:** It is important to **push** the tube in order to force sealant into the seam and create a tight seal.
