


Assembly Instructions

CONE CHANDELIER / CONE PENDANT

Assembly:

WARNING: RISK OF FIRE AND ELECTRIC SHOCK. THIS PRODUCT IS TO BE INSTALLED BY A QUALIFIED ELECTRICIAN ONLY.

The chandelier base should be installed by a qualified electrician only, (See separate hardwire installation instructions.)

- (figure 1) Open the slot in the back of the mesh shade and slide the socket on the end of the cord into the shade.
- 2. (figure 1) Close the slot to conceal the socket and pinch the shade in a bit just above the socket so that the shade grips the socket.
- 3. (figure 1) Attach a coil above the shade.
- (figure 2) Slide the cages onto each socket with the slightly bent corners facing outwards. Then secure with a plastic ring.
- (figure 1) Gently pull the shade down until snug on cage and slide the coil down until the shade is securely held between the coil and the cage.
- Feel free to manipulate, bend, squeeze the shade to a desired shape. Repeat the process for each shade.
- Turn on, and enjoy! We recommend a 60 watt clear type B Torpedo shaped-bulb.



CARE

Mesh shade . . .

Metal mesh will naturally change over time developing a richer, deeper color. The acids and oils from your hands quicken this process. For this reason, it is important to clean your hands with soap and water, drying thoroughly, before handling your shade. Rubbing alcohol (70% isopropyl) applied with a soft nylon brush may help for spot cleaning. Wipe and dry with a clean cloth, or spots may appear from the mesh being damp. (Do not use household copper or brass cleaners, as they will permanently stain the shade.)
