Assembly Instructions



Parts Included: (pictures not to scale)



Assembly:

1. UNPLUG LAMP BASE.
2. Wash hands before handling mesh. Try to touch the mesh as little as possible. Install bulb into lamp base.
3. **(figure 1)** Attach the bulb clip over the bulb until it grips the bulb tightly.
4. **(figure 1)** Place the shade over the bulb clip.
5. **(figure 1)** Place the washer on top of the shade, with threaded part of the bulb clip coming through the hole in the washer.
6. **(figure 1)** Secure with the shade by screwing the finial onto the bulb clip.
7. We recommend a clear 25 watt type CA (Candelabra) Bulb. Turn on, and enjoy!










LITTLE SIS

Assembly:

1. UNPLUG LAMP BASE.
2. Wash hands before handling mesh. Try to touch the mesh as little as possible. Install bulb into lamp base.
3. **(figure 1)** Attach the bulb clip over the bulb until it grips the bulb tightly.
4. **(figure 1)** Place the shade over threaded part of the bulb clip coming through.
5. **(figure 1)** Secure with the shade by screwing the finial onto the bulb clip.
6. If you have the Little Sis design, Feel free to manipulate, bend, squeeze the shade to a desired shape. If you have the Ariel design, gently crease the folds of the shade if necessary.
7. We recommend a clear 25-watt type CA (Candelabra) Bulb. Turn on, and enjoy!



SAFETY INFORMATION

SAFETY

We have designed your lamp to meet the highest UL and CUL safety standards.

This portable lamp has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other) as a feature to reduce electric shock. This plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Never use with an extension cord unless plug can be fully inserted. Do not alter the plug.

CARE

Mesh shade . . .

Metal mesh will naturally change over time developing a richer, deeper color. The acids and oils from your hands quicken this process. For this reason, it is important to clean your hands with soap and water, drying thoroughly, before handling your shade. Rubbing alcohol (70% isopropyl) applied with a soft nylon brush may help for spot cleaning. Wipe and dry with a clean cloth, or spots may appear from the mesh being damp. (Do not use household copper or brass cleaners, as they will permanently stain the shade.)
