

TISSUE HOLDER INSTALLATION ☐ Mark the pilot hole locations vertically 3 1/2" apart. Figure E Pilot holes (Figure D). Select a drill and bit that are appropriate for the wall material you will be drilling through. Carefully drill a 5/16" hole at all marked pilot hole locations. NOTE: If you encounter a stud during drilling, stop immediately and use only the mount screws. Back plate Figure D Install the anchors as shown in Figure E. Mount the back plate to wall using the mount screws as Back plate shown in Figure F. Anchor Install skirt and tissue rod over post on back plate. Tighten set screw to hold tissue rod in place.
