



Cleaning recommendations for chair parts made of Polypropylen (PP)

If chair parts are being used normally and according to the intended purpose they usually do not need any special or extensive cleaning.

Slight staining can be removed with the help of a wettish piece of cloth or a sponge. In case of heavier soiling, you might want to add some kind of sparing detergent (like soap or similar soft purifiers).

Attention:

- Sharp or scrubbing detergents cannot be used, as they might cause damages on the surface of the chair parts. To this belong also liquid detergents that contain abrasive ingredients like precipitate chalk, marble powder or similar additives.

- For cleaning please do only use clothes and lobes or natural or artificial sponges: if need be you might also want to use a soft brush, to reach the recess of the surface structure. In no case you should apply any kind of so called cleaning-pads (similar to pot-pads) made of plastic or even steel-wool. Such pads especially tend to damage the surface of the chair parts permanently.

Soiling by pens, markers, felt-tip pens or lipsticks or similar things should be removed immediately -before drying- if possible and in the above explained way.

Severe or hardly removable soiling, e.g. varnish, glue, spray colors or dried marks of pens, felt tip pens, etc. should be taken off only by a specialist. Special plastic detergents, e.g. Acmosol (to get by VS) – only used seldom and then moderately – do not harm an otherwise faultless surface, however we cannot recommend a self-contained use of our clients because of physiological reasons.
