Specifications

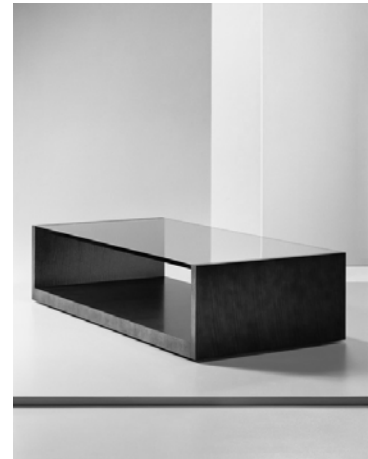
Side, coffee and console tables are available in maple, ash, and option A exotic wood veneers quartered and slip matched with .75" thick clear glass or stone tops.







Options – Specify:

Top: .75" thick clear glass with clear polished edge or 3 grades of .75" Marble, Granite and Limestone

Wood: Maple is standard; Ash may be specified for an additional \$220 list charge per table. Option A woods may also be specified at an additional charge, please see far right column below for specifics.

Finishes: Standard and custom finishes; Cerused finishes are available on Ash for an additional charge of \$140 list per item.

Notes on the optional use of Option A Woods and Finishes

Option A Woods are species, not finishes. By default, they are offered as shown on the samples and in the finish selector with little or no stain added, to show their natural beauty. Option A Woods can also be finished in the standard MP-Finishes, as long as the Option A Wood is lighter than the standard finish you select.
