



To create the back crest of the new Harpswell Stool, we begin with a three-inch-block of cherry, called a "twelve-quarter" by the lumber mills. As we carve into the block, swirling grain patterns emerge. Each crest is an individual canvas - no two are alike. When the seats are lined up together the effect is stunning. We've added our skill as joiners of wood, but nature has held the paintbrush.
