Only one flat plane exists on each chair, where the back and the seat joint are reinforced. Otherwise, it seems more carved than assembled. The shapely legs are faceted and splayed to provide stability without bulk. The seat is wide and as comfortable as any solid wood dining chair could be without upholstery. The slender back of the Side Chair scrolls up from this strong foundation, using the least amount of material needed to comfortably support the sitter.
