Care and Cleaning

Thermoplastic – Clean with mild all-purpose cleaner, water and sponge or soft cloth. Wipe down surfaces with damp sponge and dry with a soft cloth. Using a soft bristled brush, apply light pressure to soiled areas in creases and crevasses.

Laminate – Use a damp cloth or sponge and a mild soap or detergent. Difficult stains such as coffee or tea can be removed using a mild household cleaner or detergent and a soft bristled brush, repeating as necessary. If a stain persists, apply a paste of baking soda and water using a soft bristled brush and scrub lightly. Excessive scrubbing or exerting too much force could damage the decorative surface, especially if it has a gloss finish. Do not use steel wool or other abrasive pads for cleaning; doing so will damage laminate.

Veneer – Clean by wiping down with a slightly damp soft towel or cloth. Use a clean soft cloth or paper towel to remove dust. Use a furniture polish recommended for the appropriate wood finish. To avoid polish build up, do not polish more than 3 times a year. Too much polish may build up a cloudy film; wipe off polish thoroughly before it dries completely.

Excessive dampness, dryness, heat or cold can damage wood furniture. Excessive sunlight can change the color. Wipe up spills at once to prevent spots or stains.
