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




## 522 TOKYO OUTDOOR Charlotte Perriand

*Chaise longue basculante en bambou et bois, Charlotte Perriand 1940  
Adaptée du modèle en métal de 1928*

The seat of this chaise longue is composed of 12 curved wooden strips (teak, beech or bamboo). The joining elements connecting the strips to the bars below are satin brass studs. The base is in solid wood (teak, beech or bamboo). The mattress comes with water-draining polyurethane upholstery and stain resistant polyester yarn coated in PVC treated with an exclusive formulation, called Glen Raven, guaranteed totally mould resistant and ISO 9001 certified. Available in 5 colours. The materials and construction techniques employed aim to provide resistance to humidity and heat also in covered outdoor areas, such as porches and verandas. Each chaise longue comes with a protective waterproof cover for the winter season.



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It was a pair of bamboo sugar tongs, designed for the Tokyo Institute, that gave Charlotte Perriand the idea of taking the chromium-plated steel chaise longue of 1928 and replacing the steel with bamboo, thus pushing the technique to its very limit.
