






1. Install Conduit and junction box (By Others) to be used with this product.




Phase 2 - Finish Installation of Fixture with Power Canopy Ballast.



Remove one or two wire entrance knockouts on wall plate. Pull primary branch circuit wiring necessary for installation through knockout(s). Attach wall plate to junction box using appropriate hardware (By Others).




Ground primary branch circuit to wall plate per NEC. Use wire connectors (By Others) to connect ballast primary leads to branch circuit wires. See wiring diagram.




WIRING DIAGRAM

Connect fixture to ballast using provided quick



Mount canopy to Universal Mounting Ring with four (4) #8-32 stainless steel screws using 3/32" Allen wrench. Do not over tighten.






Lamp Installation Or Re-Lamping if Required for T4 Metal Halide Lamp



 Use 7/64" Allen wrench to loosen #6-32 stainless set screws and remove cap.



- Firmly insert lamp pins into socket to make connection.
- $\underline{\hat{\Lambda}}$ Do not exceed the maximum wattage listed on the fixture label before installing.



- . Place cap on fixture and tighten set screws. Tighten screw to 1/2 in-lbs. Top of screws should sit flush with fixture cap.
- Marning: Do not over tighten. Doing so will compromise O-ring seal and will void warranty.
