



Instructions:

- 1. Remove mounting plate from lamp plate by loosening (2) thumb nuts.
- 2. Fasten the mounting plate to junction box with junction box screws (by others).
- Make all necessary wire connections according to national and local electrical 3. codes.
- 4. Fasten lamp plate on ceiling mounting plate with provided thumb nuts.
- 5. Install proper lamps (by others) per relamp label.
- Align the (3) lock pins on the lens and trim assembly with the (3) lock pin slots on the 6. lamp plate by using (2) assistant studs on the lamp plate and rotate lens and trim assembly clockwise. Be sure lens is securely closed.
