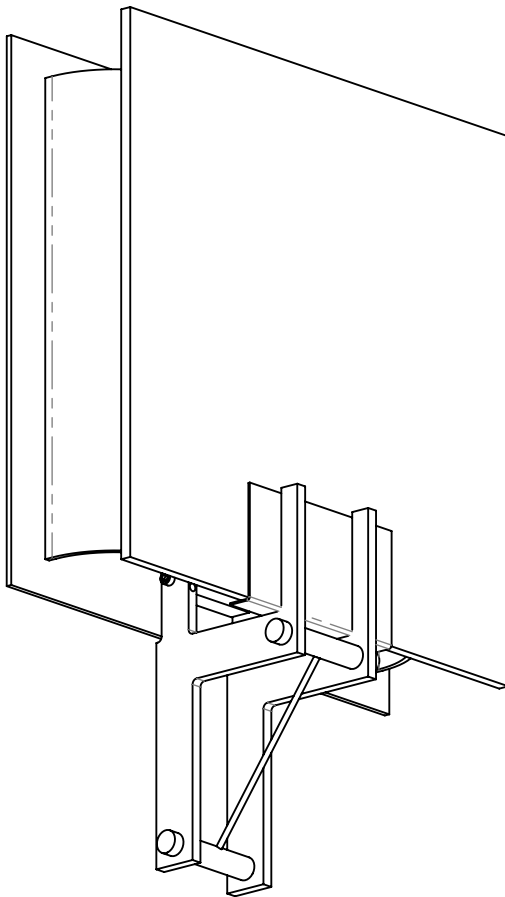

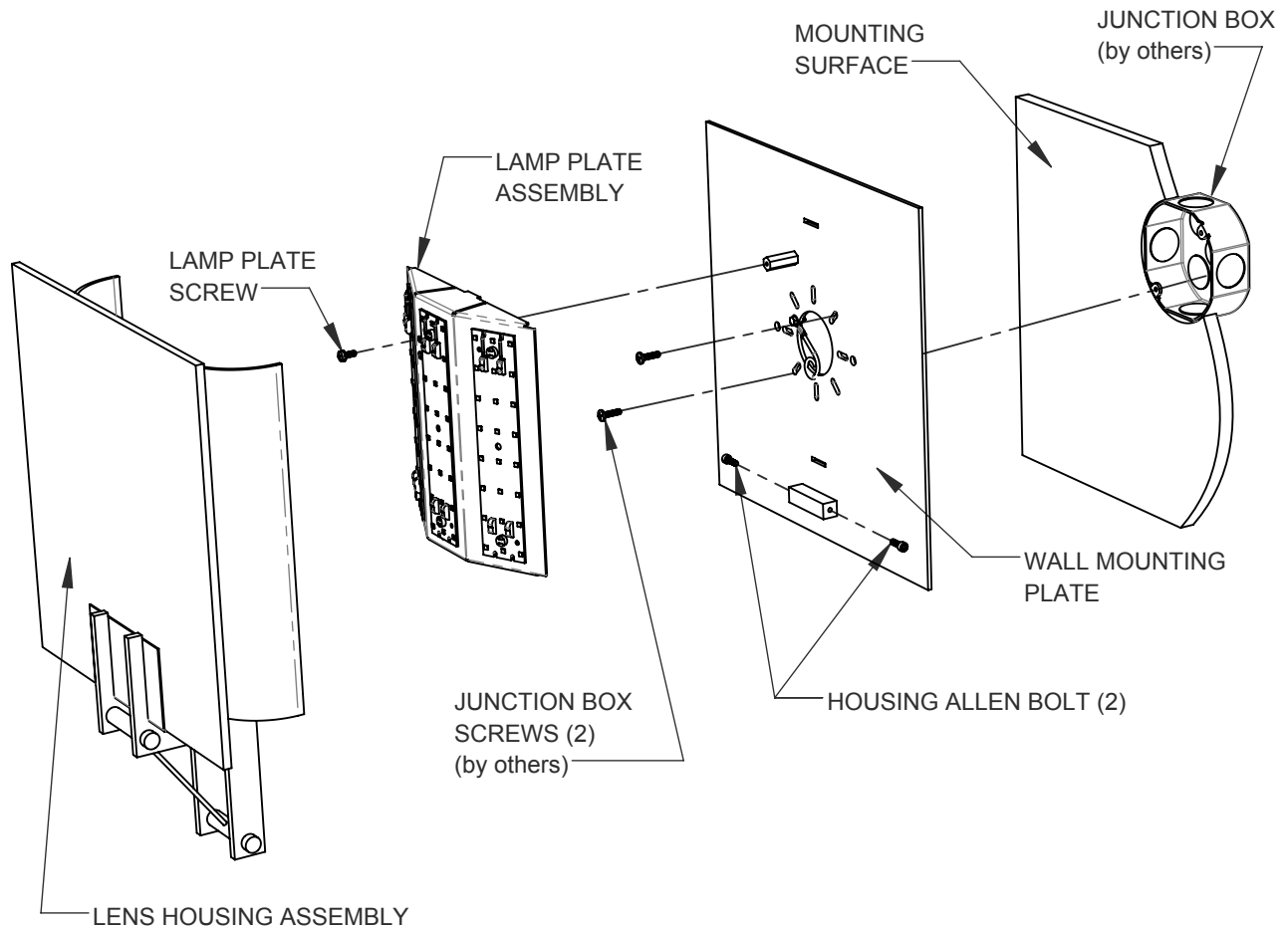

1. Remove housing allen bolts from lens housing assembly.
2. Remove lens housing assembly and set aside.
3. Remove lamp plate assembly from wall mounting plate by removing the lamp plate screw.
4. Install the wall mounting plate to junction box and secure with junction box screws (by others).
5. Make all wire connections per national and local electrical codes.
6. Reinstall lamp plate assembly and secure with the lamp plate screw.
7. Reinstall lens housing assembly with housing allen bolts.
