Ashbery lights have patent-pending photometrics and cast aluminum frames with powdercoat finish in a full selection of colors. The group includes 12', 14' and 16' tall pedestrian lights, a 3' tall pathway light and a wall-mounted light.









Pedestrian lights are offered with single luminaires or with a double-mount option for dual luminaires, one on either side of the pole.

Luminaires house LEDs at appropriate aiming angles, in polar arrays, behind a diffuser lens to provide low-glare lighting that emits a pleasing glow in a gradient of light from the center outward. A separate LED element mounted in the fixture below the lens subtly recalls gas lamps or early filament bulbs, triggering an emotive moment that enhances experience and the sense of place.
