Safety Data Sheets (SDS) – Finished Goods: noraplan[®], norament[®], norament[®] stairtreads

Dear Customer,

This information provides clarification regarding the need in having Safety Data Sheets available for the rubber products that nora systems, Inc. manufactures and distributes in North America.


According to the Hazard Communication Standard of the Occupational Safety and Health Administration, Requirement [29CFR1910.1200(c)], SDS documents are required for all hazardous chemicals; however, these standards specify that the regulation does not apply to “articles”.

“Article means a manufactured item other than a fluid or particle: (i) which is formed to a specific shape or design during manufacture; (ii) which has end use function(s) dependent in whole or in part upon its shape or design during end use; and (iii) which under normal conditions of use does not release more than very small quantities, e.g., minute or trace amounts of a hazardous chemical (as determined under paragraph (d) of this section), and does not pose a physical hazard or health risk to employees.”

Because nora’s rubber products are resilient, stable finished materials with no physical hazards or health risks, they fall into the category of “articles”. We wish to advise you that all rubber finished products manufactured and distributed by nora systems, Inc. are therefore exempt from the SDS requirements.
