Please read all instructions before installing corner guard.

Flexible Corner Guard

3/4" **Important** [19mm] OR 1<u>1</u>" 1. Acclimate materials 24 hrs [37.6] before installation. Maintain temperature controlled environment after installation 2. Install in accordance with manufacturer's installation instructions. Failure to do so **FLEXIBLE** PVC .110" will void the warranty. [3mm] FLEXIBLE PVC .110" STUD/BACKER [3mm] (BY OTHER) 3/4" [19mm] or 1¹/₂" [38.6] STUD/BACKER (BY OTHER)





Components and Fasteners




Flexible Corner Guard

Installation Instructions

Flexible Corner Guard



Please read all instructions before installing corner guards. Material must be stored, installed and used in environmentally controlled conditions.

1. Prior to installation:

- a. Allow corner guards to reach room temperature before installing.
- b. The wall surface that the corner guards are to be applied must be dry and free of dirt, dust, oil, loose pain, wax and grease.
- 2. Use IPC #535 Heavy-Duty Adhesive to adhere corner guards. Apply a bead of IPC #535 in a zig-zag pattern over the back of the corner guard. See Figure 1a. Immediately position corner guard on the wall and apply pressure until a tight fit is achieved. An extension roller will aid this step. Additional bracing may be required during installation to insure complete contract with the wall. See Figure 1b.

Adhesive Coverage: One 10.6 oz cartridge of IPC #535 Heavy-Duty Adhesive will adhere the following corner guards based on an approximate cover of 70 lf per cartridge.
