TWO PEDESTAL KNEESPACE CREDENZA

Note: For more detailed information on installing pedestals, refer to assembly direction 939500237.

- **1.** Remove drawers to gain access to remove screws holding pedestals to worksurface.
- **2.** Reconfigure pedestals from one side to the other.
- **3.** Secure with screws that were removed in step 1.
- **4.** Reinstall drawers into pedestals.






Credenzas with storage are modular and may be reconfigured. Remove pedestals and switch from one side to the other. Screws that attach modesty panel to unit may need to be removed.




END PANEL / PEDESTAL KNEESPACE CREDENZA

- **1.** Remove drawers to gain access to remove screws holding pedestal to worksurface.
- 2. Remove end panel.
- **3.** Switch pedestal to opposite end and position new end panel.
- **4.** Secure components with screws that were removed in steps 1 and 2.
- **5.** Reinstall drawers into pedestal.

CONNECT AN END PANEL TO A BACK PANEL

- **1.** Carefully turn worksurface over onto carpet or other clean, soft material.
- **2.** Insert cam pins into pilot holes in the bottom of worksurface as shown.
- **3.** Insert (3) shoulder screws into holes in the back panel.

4. Align back panel with end panel (4a) and insert the shoulder screws into the clips (4b). With screw head inserted into clip push back panel downward (4c) until it is secured (4d).
