Cleaning Code WS + BC: Clean with mild detergent or shampoo, foam or water-free solvent as desired. Do not saturate with liquid.

Regular Cleaning and Maintenance (Dirt, Dust, and Grime)

Clean the soiled area with mild soap and water, then rinse with fresh water and wipe dry with a clean cloth.

Food Stains/Oils (Ketchup, Chocolate, Coffee/Tea, Salad Dressing, etc.)

Wipe the affected area with a soft cloth or soft bristle brush using non-abrasive cleaner, for example Formula 409 or Fantastik. Rinse with fresh water and wipe dry.

Healthcare/Disinfection (Blood, Urine, Betadine, Disinfectant)

Clean the soiled area with a 20% solution of household bleach and water. Rinse the cleaned area with fresh water.

Disinfection: Virex or equivalent hospital grade disinfectant cleaners can be used. Always test on inconspicuous area prior to use. It is important to rinse the cleaned area with fresh water after applying disinfecting solutions.

Difficult Stains (Eye Shadow/Mascara, Lipstick, Crayon, Grease, Mustard)

Clean the soiled area with 50% solution of isopropyl alcohol (rubbing alcohol) and water. Alternatively, use 20% bleach solution. Rinse the cleaned area with fresh water after applying the cleaning solution.

Ink Marks/Graffiti (Ballpoint Pen, Permanent Marker, Paint)

Rub the affected area with 50% solution of isopropyl alcohol (rubbing alcohol) and water. Rinse cleaned area with fresh water promptly after applying alcohol.

Note: Removal of ink, particularly permanent marker, may vary depending on the period of time that the ink sets in. Full removal is not guaranteed.

Please be careful: These instructions are for the fabric only. Some fabric cleaning methods may cause damage to underlying materials used to make the furniture item.
