1. Range of Motion

Mbrace has a 22-inch height-adjustment range, which accommodates seated or standing positions for most people, regardless of their size. A counterbalance mechanism allows for knob-free repositioning, so anyone can adjust the support and use it comfortably. A 180-degree rotation makes for seamless information sharing.

Installation

Mbrace can be installed on Compass System tiles and other common surfaces in 30 minutes, minimizing downtime. This wall-mounted solution is also seismically tested and OSHPD-approved to withstand earthquakes up to 7.3 magnitude.
