

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
Removal of VBC Cable


1. Press seat slide handle (at front of seat) and pull seat as far forward as it will go.

2. Tip the chair onto its right side.

3. Locate the seat out stop feature.

4. Insert a screwdriver below the out stop feature and push it (up) toward the seat.





Steelcase Removal of VBC Cable 6. Adjust chair to highest position by activating the seat height lever. Rotate back-tilt knob up to relax cable tension. Lift cable wire slightly and detach cable plug and cable wire from back-tilt cam. 7. 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


8. Turn chair over. Use Torx T20 bit to remove four (4) screws. Remove guard plate. **NOTE:** Grease is applied to pneumatic cylinder column. Take care with hands and clothing.


9. Lift cable guide block with VBC cable. Note alignment pin locations for reinstallation reference.

10. Carefully remove VBC cable from cable block. Reverse steps for replacement (new) cable.

11. Assemble seat onto chair by aligning slots in the back of the seat with the slide bearings. Push seat from the front while simultaneously pressing the seat slide handle. Push the seat with enough force to move beyond the seat out stop feature. Once positioned, press the seat slide handle and pull the seat forward to verify the seat is properly assembled to the chair.







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
