Wall Mounted Shelf

Tools Required

- Cordless Drill
- #2 Phillips Head Bit
- Tape Measure
- Level

Hardware Contents

- Shelf Support Brackets
- Self-Drilling Drywall Anchors

Installation

- 1. Mark and draw a level line on the wall for desired shelf location. Measure down 1/2" below top line for center location of shelf brackets. (Figure A)
- 2. Mark a line on the wall where the end of the shelf will be. (Figure A)
- 3. Measure from edge of shelf to center of route (A) and mark dimension on the wall for the bracket location. Repeat for all routes center to center (B) for bracket locations. (Figure B)
- 4. Attach the shelf bracket to the wall with self-drilling EZ toggle drywall anchors and screws provided. Repeat for all brackets. Attach steel rod to shelf bracket. (Figure C)
- 5. Note: Drywall Anchors are reverse self drilling through drywall then forward screw to tighten.
- 6. Place shelf on steel rods and push flush to the wall.

NOTE: Bracket is adjustable up/down and right/left. Shelf can be adjusted level by loosening/tightening the steel rod.




